The German Deaf Sports Federation is pleased to deliver some more information about the Dresse & Maere Tennis Cup (World Deaf Tennis Cup) 2007 in Munich from 21st to 28th July 2007.

Venue of the Competitions

The tennis matches will take place on the tennis courts of the tennis club "Grün-Weiß Luitpoldpark" in Munich.



The tennis club „Grün Weiß Luitpoldpark“ provides:

- 10 sand courts (8 courts for the championships and 2 courts for training);
- 2 of them with seats for spectators;
- restaurant for 80 people with an open air terrace;
- 2 locker rooms for each, women and men, for about 50 players;
- 1 room for the ambulance;
- 1 room for the organisation committee;
- 20 parking lots;
- space for information booths;

The tennis courts are closed to the public transport connections

- about 20 parking lots;
- a hospital and general practitioners;
- supermarkets;
- internet cafes;
- a big amusement park;

In case of bad weather

The „Sport Scheck Allwetteranlage“ in Munich is a versatile sports facility with a tennis school, tennis halls and tennis courts.

- 12 courts inside with:
- one hall for tournaments with Rebound Ace lining
- one 3-courts-hall with Rebound Ace lining
- 5 single halls with fabrics lining
- one 3-court-airhouse with sand lining





Hotels – Accommodation

The DGS offers three different hotels for the accommodation of the participating delegations according to the following conditions:

1. Hotel Europa (Hotel of the German delegation), 4 stars

The Hotel Europa is located in the centre of Munich city; each room includes amenities as bath, cable television, direct dial telephone and mini-bar. For added convenience the hotel also boasts an Italian restaurant, coffee lounge and banquet rooms. Here technical meeting and draw will take place.

twin room (2 single beds)	61.50 \$ / 50 € per person, incl. breakfast
costs for half board	17 \$ / 14 € - menu with three dishes

2. Hotel Star Inn, 3 stars

The Hotel Star Inn is located in the beautiful München Schwabing, each room includes amenities as bath, LCD-TV, direct internet access. For added convenience the hotel also boasts an extensive lobby, a hotelbar, conference corner and free 24 hours internet access.

twin room (2 single beds)	49 \$ / 40 € per Person, excl. breakfast
costs for breakfast	12.50 \$ / 10 € - breakfast buffet

3. on demand

Haus International

This offers the possibility to book a bed in a shared or a single room incl. breakfast for 30 \$ / 24 € up to 57.50 \$ / 47 € per person. The Haus International meets the standard of a high-class Inter-Youth Hostel.

3. For Tourists and Visitors of the WM

Park Hotel Schwabing, 3 stars

The DGS has reserved a limited room contingent in the Park Hotel Schwabing for visitors and tourists. It is also located in the beautiful München Schwabing. Due to their small size the rooms are not suitable for athletes. Each room includes amenities as bath, SAT television; direct dial telephone and internet access. For added convenience the hotel also boasts a restaurant offering national and international specialties, a swimming pool and a bistro bar.

twin room (2 single beds)	55 \$ / 45 € per Person, incl. breakfast
costs for half board	15 \$ / 12 € - menu with three dishes

All rooms may be booked via the German Deaf Sports Federation. Reservations and a deposit of 50 % of the total will have to be paid together with the final entry at the DGS main office at 20 April 2007 for the latest. For this purpose DGS will send out a respective form after the deadline for the preliminary entry.

All payments for board and lodging have to be made in **EURO!**

***The dollar prices refer to the exchange rate at time of establishing this document.



Transport

The DGS is offering transport for the delegations to and fro the tennis courts and the hotel as well as to and fro Munich's central station and airport. Apart from this the DGS for visitors and tourists is offering transport services to and fro the tennis courts and the hotel as well as to and fro Munich's central station and airport for a fee of 30 € per week and person. Visitors, using this service will be provided with accreditation.



Bond

In accordance with the ICSD a bond of 500 \$ / 375 € will have to be transferred on the DGS bank account together with the final entry. This bond is dedicated to the hosting federation in case of unforeseen cancellations of countries at too short notice, to cover the costs which may already have occurred due to an entry.



Program and Entry

The preliminary program of the Dresse & Maere Tennis Cup and the entry form are enclosed in this bulletin.



A minimum 2 women or 2 men must be entered for the Dresse & Maere Tennis Cup, a maximum of 4 women and 4 men may be entered. Each team must nominate a playing or non-playing captain. No reserve players may be entered.

Date of the preliminary entry: 20 January 2007

Date of the final entry

(together with the transfer of the bond of 375 € and 50% of the total of hotel costs on the DGS bank account, to be paid in EURO) 20 April 2007.

Date for the registration of names 15 June 2007



The final entry fee will be announced as soon as the ICSD Congress will have decided about the new scale of charges and fees 2007 in Salt Lake City next year.

Entries shall be made by mail, email or fax directly to the DGS main office.
