WORLD DEAF MARTIAL ARTS CHAMPIONSHIPS

General Technical Rules

Art 1: 13th World Deaf Martial Arts Championships will take place at Toulouse, France from 21–25 May 2008. International Martial Arts Federation of the Deaf (IMAFD) is an Association Member of ICSD. This Championship is being organizing by French Deaf Sport Federation.

Art 2: The disciplines will provide during 13th World Deaf Martial Arts Championships are:
Judo, Karate, Taekwondo and Wushu.

Art 3: Each ICSD Technical Directors have the responsibility to make sure the conditions for the event will be met.

Karate	François KHALEF (FRA)
Taekwondo	Jung-bae PARK (KOR)

Art 4: Each discipline will follow the rules from each International Sports Federation: International Judo Federation (IJF), World Karate Federation (WKF), World Taekwondo Federation (WTF) and International Wushu Federation (IWU.F).

Art 5: Each event is conformed to the federation recognized (see Art.4)

Art 6: Acceptable Markings on the Judogi or Karategi or others:

Art 6.1: National Olympic Abbreviation (on back of jacket), size of the letters 11cm.

Art 6.2: National Emblem (on left breast of jacket), maximum size 100cm².

Art 6.3: All the other marking aren't allowed.

Art 7: Each National Association may enter two (2) competitors per weight class, in each gender.

Art 8: The use of hearing aids or external cochlear implant aids is strictly forbidden during the competition.

Art 9: The registration form must be signed by the President and the Secretary. If the registration is not signed, it will be declined.

Art 9.1: The Preliminary registrations with an indication of the probable number of competitors in each discipline and event have been submitted to French Sport Deaf Federation by **30 November 2007**.

Art 9.2: The final registrations with the names of each competitor indicating discipline and event entered must be submitted to the French Sport Deaf Federation no later than **1 March 2008**. Such submissions may be made by telefax or E-mail if followed by the official registration form.

Art 10: ICSD Deaf World Championships regulations will be in effect. (**See WC1 General Information**)

Additional regulations for each discipline are enclosed.

KARATE – TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

Art 1 TECHNICAL COMMITTEE:

The Technical Committee is composed of the ICSD Technical Director for Karate: KHALEF François (FRA).

Art 2 CLOTHING:

The karategi uniform must be white and clean without stripes or piping. The jacket, when tightened around the waist with the belt, must be of a minimum length that covers the hips, but must not be more than three-quarters thigh length. Female competitors may wear a plain white T-shirt beneath the Karate jacket. **Contestants must bring two colour belts (red and blue).**

The maximum length of the jacket sleeves must be no longer than the bend of the wrist and no shorter than halfway down the forearm. Jacket sleeves may not be rolled up.

The trousers must be long enough to cover at least two thirds of the shin and must not reach below the anklebone. Trouser legs may not be rolled up.

Contestants must keep their hair clean and cut to a length that does not obstruct smooth bout conduct. Hachimaki (headband) will not be allowed. Should the Referee consider any contestant's hair too long and/or unclean, he may disbar the contestant from the bout. In Kumite or Kata matches hair slides are prohibited, as are metal hairgrips.

Contestants must have short fingernails and must not wear metallic or other objects, which might injure their opponents.

The following protective equipment is compulsory for the competitors to wear and they must be approved by WKF: mitts (red and blue), mouthpiece, female chest protector, groin guard for male, shin pads (red and blue) and foot protection (red and blue).

The mitts, shin pads, foot protection, and groin guard for men / chest protector for women shall be worn beneath the Karategi uniform.

Art 4 REGULATIONS:

The rules of Karate are conformed to the regulations of World Karate Federation (WKF). The Technical Committee has the right to study the accessibility for competitors and estimate the test as example “yame”.

The official list of Katas is conformed to the list of WKF Caution, the competitors may be submitted the Shitei Kata by the judge in case of the numerous of competitors. Each competitor must not take the same kata than the precedent round and must announce the name of kata at the official table before to enter the competition.

Art 5 HYGIENE:

The Karategi shall be clean, generally dry and without unpleasant odour

The nails of the feet and hands shall be cut short

The personal hygiene of the contestant shall be of a high standard

Long hair shall be tied so as to avoid causing inconvenience to the other contestant

Art 6 TECHNICAL MEETING:

The Karate technical meeting will be held at **Toulouse**. Each participating National Association may be represented by two officials, of whom at least one must be deaf and, if necessary, an interpreter and the competitors.

JUDO - TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

Art 1 TECHNICAL COMMITTEE:

The Technical Committee is composed of the ICSD Technical Director for Judo: ANTOINE Damien (FRA).

Art 2 CLOTHING:

The Judo uniform (judogi) will be conducted in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the IJF. The contestants shall wear a Judogi (**blue and white**) uniform strongly made of cotton (more than 70% cotton) or similar material, in good condition. The material must not be so thick or hard or slippery as to prevent the opponent from taking a grip. The back identification (Bibs) worn by the competitors shall be made from white material and maximum dimensions is 30cm x 30cm. Each competitor must bring the judogi blue and white.

Art 3 EVENTS:

The Judo competitions will comprise the following events:

Art 4 REGULATIONS:

The rules of Judo are conformed to the regulations of International Judo Federation (IJF). The Technical Committee has the right to study the accessibility for competitors and estimate the test. Each competitor must not excess of 7 fighting during the daytime.

Art 5 HYGIENE:

The Judogi shall be clean, generally dry and without unpleasant odour

The nails of the feet and hands shall be cut short

The personal hygiene of the contestant shall be of a high standard

Long hair shall be tied so as to avoid causing inconvenience to the other contestant

Art 6 TECHNICAL MEETING:

The Judo technical meeting will be held at **Toulouse**. Each participating National Association may be represented by two officials, of whom at least one must be deaf and, if necessary, an interpreter and the competitors.

TAEKWONDO - TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

Art 1 TECHNICAL COMMITTEE:

The Technical Committee is composed of the ICSD Technical Director for Taekwondo: PARK Jung-Bae (KOR).

Art 2 CLOTHING:

The contestant shall wear the trunk protector, head protector, groin guard, forearm guards, shin guards, gloves and mouthpieces before entering the contest area. The groin guard, forearm guards and shin guards shall be worn beneath the Taekwondo uniform. The contest shall bring this WTF-approved protective equipment, as well as gloves and the mouthpieces, for his/her personal use. Wearing any item on the head other than the head protector shall not be permitted.

The rules of Taekwondo are conformed to the regulations of World Taekwondo Federation (WTF). The Technical Committee has the right to study the accessibility for competitors and estimate the test.

Art 5 HYGIENE:

The Uniform shall be clean, generally dry and without unpleasant odour

The nails of the feet and hands shall be cut short

The personal hygiene of the contestant shall be of a high standard

Long hair shall be tied so as to avoid causing inconvenience to the other contestant

Art 6 TECHNICAL MEETING:

The Taekwondo technical meeting will be held at **Toulouse**. Each participating National Association may be represented by two officials, of whom at least one must be deaf and, if necessary, an interpreter and the competitors.

WUSHU - TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

Art 1 TECHNICAL COMMITTEE:

The Technical Committee is composed of the ICSD Technical Director for Wushu: TO BE ANNOUNCED

Art 2 CLOTHING:

The Wushu uniform may be white or black and clean. All the protectors for fighting must be approval by the International Wushu Federation (IWUF)

The Wushu competitions will comprise the following events:

The rules of Wushu are conformed to the regulations of International Wushu Federation (IWUF). The Technical Committee has the right to study the accessibility for competitors and estimate the test.

The Wushu uniform shall be clean, generally dry and without unpleasant odour

The nails of the feet and hands shall be cut short

The personal hygiene of the contestant shall be of a high standard

Long hair shall be tied so as to avoid causing inconvenience to the other contestant

Art 6 TECHNICAL MEETING:

The Wushu technical meeting will be held at **Toulouse**. Each participating National Association may be represented by two officials, of whom at least one must be deaf and, if necessary, an interpreter and the competitors.
